There are no other additional costs for use of Club equipment including target faces and other consumables. Voluntary contributions are however requested towards any beverages if provided.

*Summer and Winter "Anytime" membership allows free access to Six Gold End for the relevant season(s) only.
Not available to Beginners for 1st season.

Poor ground conditions Should committee close access to Six Gold End for longer than 50% of a Winter season due to poor ground conditions *Winter Anytime* members will be refunded a maximum of 50% of the excess over standard membership.
Refunds do not apply to Winter outdoors only members.

Weekly Sessions

Summer: Tuesday and Thursday evenings after 5pm, Saturday mornings 10am-1pm and Sunday afternoons 2pm-5pm

Winter: Tuesday evenings 6.00pm-9.00pm, Saturday mornings 10am-1pm. Subject to economic viability - times may be reduced.

Enforced closure Should Club facilities be withdrawn due to government legislation, regulatory body (e.g. AGB) instruction or the like the Club will reimburse members pro rata for that period of closure.

A family discount (minimum one adult, one under 18) of 10% will be applied to all family members *except* for full Annual Membership where it will NOT apply to the first adult but only to the 2nd and subsequent adults and all Under 18 direct family member fees. Family discount does not apply to affiliation fees.

Payment of Annual or Seasonal Subscriptions – By either a single lump sum prior to the Year/Season starting, or by monthly Direct Debit payments spread over 6 months (seasonal) or 12 months (annual).

Direct Debit payments are subject to a 50p monthly surcharge to cover 3rd party processing charges and are only available to members after 3 months membership. Direct Debit payment is not available for *Winter Outdoors only* membership.

Important: Members paying by Direct Debit who resign from the club during the year/season being paid for will be liable for any remaining unpaid balance on the class of membership they hold current at the time of resignation.

Affiliation fees charged in addition on 1st September annually

Members' fees to Archery GB (AGB), West Midlands Archery Society (WMAS) and County of Worcester Archery (CWAA) will be collected separately on 1st September to align with AGB year. Due to the differing times at which these 3 bodies announce their fees it is not possible to be exact but based on recent figures this should be about £58.00 for adults aged 25 and over, £13.00 for juniors and £19.50 for young adults aged under 25 on 1st October of subscription year.

Affiliate Members

All the above memberships are available to archers who are members of Archery GB and wish to join DAS as an Affiliate member. Archery GB and County / Region fees are charged separately so no discounts are offered.

Visitor fees/Non-members (who must also be members of Archery GB) may shoot for £5/session. Contact the Club Secretary.

Special Note – Booking System: During Covid or similar restriction periods the Club will implement a web-based booking system via the Club website to control safe access to both Summer and Winter venues. This applies to ALL classes of membership. Details will be provided in advance and on the club website.

Visitors will only be granted access for substantial reasons e.g. a key worker who cannot shoot at own club times or elite archer requiring practice. Occasional recreational practice shooting in addition to or in place of visitor's own club times will be refused.
